## FOR WHOM THE FALL 2005 CLASS IS NAMED

### “Our Military Heroes”

*By The Four Presiding Officers of the Valley of Cleveland*

At this reunion, the class will be named in honor of “Our Military Heroes”. Our intention is to honor those who have served, as well as those currently serving in the military. Any Scottish Rite Mason who is a military veteran or is currently serving, and in attendance at the Fall Reunion will receive special recognition. All military (veteran and current) will be presented with a Valley pin and ribbon. The color of the ribbon will identify them as a veteran (red ribbon) or current military member (blue ribbon).

Some military Masons who served in the past are: George Washington, Rufus Putnam, Prince Hall, John Paul Jones, Marquis de Lafayette, Paul Revere, Alfred von Tirpitz, Horatio Nelson, Davy Crockett, James Bowie, George Pickett, John Phillip Sousa, John J. Pershing, Theodore Roosevelt, Basil Deacon Hobbs, James Wolfe, Ernest King, Douglas MacArthur, Charles Lindberg, Eddie Rickenbacker, Audie Murphy, Franklin D. Roosevelt, Winston Churchill, Harry Truman, Gerald Ford and John Glenn. These are just a few names that we all recognize who served proudly. The Valley chooses to honor all of the “Military Heroes”, past and current, active and reserve, domestic and allies who have served their country to preserve, protect and uphold the freedoms we all enjoy every day.

Donald Maybaugh, a member of the Valley, has been chosen to be the class representative and share some of his experiences as a POW during World War II.

Don served in the U.S. Army from 1943 to 1945. He was on the Second Wave of the invasion at Anzio beach, in Anzio, Italy and was assigned to fire the BAR (Browning Automatic Rifle). After only 18 days of combat, Maybaugh and the other 42 members of his unit were captured by the Germans. Don was transferred between six different prison camps. As Sublime Prince Donald Maybaugh begins to share his incredible story of being a German prisoner of war for 14 months, he will tell you “I am not a hero. Those guys (heroes) are all buried in Arlington, and grave sites in America and many unmarked grave sites in Europe”. He saw some incredible things, and those things need to be told.

Donald Eugene Maybaugh was born on January 6, 1924 in Cleveland, Ohio and graduated from Wellington High School in 1942. Don retired from Goodman Brothers after 20 years of employment.

Don received his Entered Apprentice and Fellowcraft Degrees while on military furlough and was Raised in Wellington Lodge No. 127 on January 14, 1946.

Don was elected Worshipful Master in 1975. He joined Wellington Chapter #109, Royal Arch Masons, in 1947 and served as High Priest in 1975. Brother Maybaugh was Knighted in Elyria Commandery #60 in 1971 and served as Commander in 1977. Don joined Elyria Council #86, Royal and Select Masons in 1976 and was Illustrious Master in 1979. Worshipful Brother Maybaugh received The Degree of Knight York Cross of Honor on October 10, 1980.

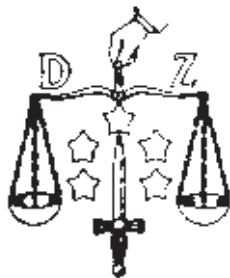
