2010 Fall Class Named for Ill. Bradford A. Goebel, 33°

The Fall Reunion Class of 2010 has been named for Ill. Bro. Bradford A. Goebel, 33°, Deputy's Representative to the Valley of Cleveland, Past Commander-in-Chief of Lake Erie Consistory, and Deputy Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Ohio. With the Grand Lodge Session taking place the week before our Reunion, it is probable that when we open our Reunion, Ill. Bro. Goebel will in fact be the Grand Master of Masons in Ohio, making this a Grand Master's Class. We will wait until after the Grand Lodge elections to make that declaration.

Two years ago, the Board of Trustees decided to change our Fall Reunion from a two day event held on the 3rd weekend in November, to a one day event at the end of October. Historically, Blue Lodge installations were usually held in the first two weeks of December. As time has marched forward, more and more Lodges have started to schedule their installations in November to the point where the Saturday of our November Reunions would have so many Lodge installations scheduled, that near the end of the Reunion, many Officers, cast, crew and members would have to leave to participate or attend their Lodge's installation. By moving our Reunion to the end of October, we eliminate this problem. Last fall would have been our first Reunion in some time scheduled in October, but the Sovereign Grand Commander scheduled the Jurisdiction Wide Reunion last year on November 14, 2009.

So, with the very high probability that Ill. Bro. Goebel will be Installed Grand Master on October 16, 2010, we should all work diligently to encourage our non-Scottish Rite brothers to join the Valley of Cleveland and become a part of this Class which will be named for the Grand Master of Ohio.
